Navigating Complex Post-Integration Strategy with Seplat Energy

We had the privilege of partnering with Seplat Energy to navigate a complex, post-integration challenge. We facilitated a high-stakes, 2-day workshop to harmonise their employment relations strategy, bringing together union and non-union representatives to design a unified, hybrid model. This strategic work was complemented by a targeted capacity-building workshop for their Joint Consultative Council (JCC) representatives, empowering them to become proactive business partners. The session was a resounding success, earning an outstanding 4.67/5 satisfaction score from participants and demonstrating our ability to broker consensus and build frameworks that foster industrial harmony.

Highlights: Driving Impact Through Environment, Technology, People, and Governance

Environmental Spotlight: The Tree4Life Project in Action

Our work on the Seplat Tree4Life initiative demonstrates our commitment to environmental stewardship practically and measurably. The project goes beyond tree planting to establish a resilient ecosystem that supports both communities and long-term sustainability.

In the first half of the year, we laid critical groundwork to ensure long-term success and accountability:



Adhering to Global Standards

By completing baseline studies and formally adopting the internationally recognised Verra methodology, we have established a clear pathway toward carbon credit certification.

Reforestation

We established two nurseries and facilitated the planting of 200,000 trees, utilising a mix of indigenous and naturalised tree species seedlings to support the restoration of the Ehor Forest Reserve.



Stakeholder Endorsement & Partnership

We hosted the Chairman of the Edo State Forestry Commission on a full tour of the Tree4Life project. He commended the project's progress and the partnership between Teasoo Consulting, Seplat Energy JV, and the state, validating our collaborative approach to reforestation.



Food Trees

A total of 5,456 out of 23,000 food trees (including ogbono and bitter kola) have been made available for the community. These are being distributed to provide farmers with alternative livelihoods and promote long-term economic stability.



Community Jobs

We established standards requiring all vendors to engage at least 60% of their low skilled workers from host communities, thereby ensuring economic empowerment for residents.



Our deep technical expertise was sought by international partners to conduct a comprehensive carbon assessment for a Nigerian Flow Station on their behalf. Our team identified and provided a preliminary quantification of Scope 1 & 2 greenhouse gas emissions—a foundational step in developing robust decarbonization strategies.

These projects embody our conviction that genuine environmental impact is founded on a foundation of meticulous planning and transparent processes.

Commitment to Social Impact

The CTY Initiative reached students in 11 schools across Edo South and Edo Central, bringing total impact to 7,000+ students in 17 schools across Edo State and Lagos.

Building Capacity for Impact
